EDUCATIONAL FOCUS:

Space Science, Technology, Innovation

HIGHLIGHTS:

ISRO Satellite Centre (URSC), HAL Aerospace Museum,

Day 2 – Bengaluru (ISRO & Innovation)

- ISRO Satellite Centre (URSC) – Satellite design & testing exposure (requires prior approval for student groups). (~2 hrs)
- Indian Institute of Science (IISc) – Campus visit/seminar in physics, space, or robotics. (~2–3 hrs)
- Evening: Group discussion or innovation workshop.
- Overnight in Bengaluru.

Day - 1 Bengaluru (Space & Technology)

- Visvesvaraya Industrial & Technological Museum – Hands-on science exhibits. (~2–3 hrs)
- HAL Aerospace Museum – Aircraft models, simulators, and aerospace history. (~2 hrs)
- Overnight in Bengaluru.
- Hotels (Student-friendly 3/4):** Pai Viceroy, Lemon Tree, Keys Select.

Hotels (Suggested) Triple/Quad Sharing

Suggested Hotels at Bengaluru: (Student-friendly 3/4):** Pai Viceroy, Lemon Tree, Keys Select.

Suggested Hotels at Tirupati: Fortune Select Grand Ridge, Hotel Bhimas Paradise.

Suggested Hotels at Chennai: Residency Towers, Accord Metropolitan, student hostels near Anna University.

Day 3 – Transfer to Sriharikota (SHAR)

- Drive/overnight transfer (~6–7 hrs) or via Tirupati.
- Sriharikota – Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC SHAR) – India's rocket launch site. Pre-arranged student visit covers:
 - Mission Control Room (viewing gallery).
 - Launch pads (when available).
 - Exhibits on India's space missions.
 - Duration: ~4 hrs visit.
 - Stay in Tirupati (student hotels near temple city).
 - Hotels: Fortune Select Grand Ridge, Hotel Bhimas Paradise.



Day 4 – Tirupati / Chennai Extension

- Option A: Tirupati cultural visit (temple architecture + engineering of water systems).
- Option B: Transfer to Chennai for STEM visits:
 - Birla Planetarium & Periyar Science Centre (~2–3 hrs).
 - Marina Beach cultural activity.
 - Overnight in Chennai.
 - Hotels: Residency Towers, Accord Metropolitan, student hostels near Anna University.



Day 5 – Departure

- Wrap-up seminar on "India's Space Journey."
- Departure from Chennai or Bengaluru airport.



Key Notes for All Itineraries



Triple/Quad Sharing: Most Ibis, Holiday Inn, and Novotel properties offer family/quad rooms or roll-away beds for groups. Always pre-confirm rooming setup.



Meals: Breakfast included at hotels; lunch/dinners arranged at student-friendly outlets (buffets at Indian Restaurants/food courts or Meal Coupons)



Transport: Private coach for airport transfers, daily sightseeing, and educational visits.
